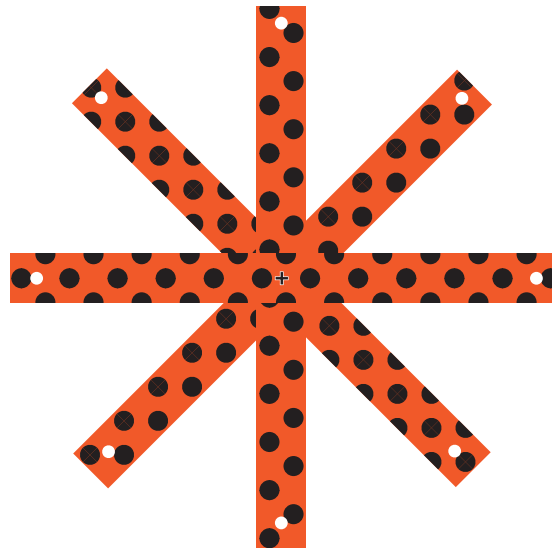
PAPER PUMPKINS

You'll need:

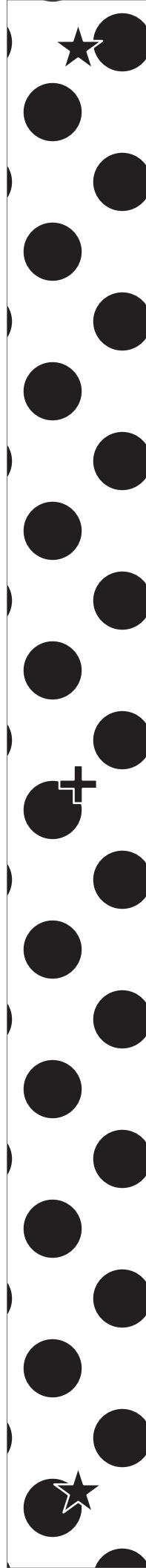
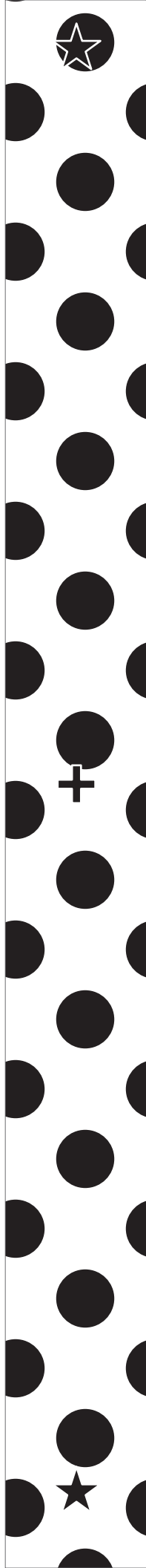
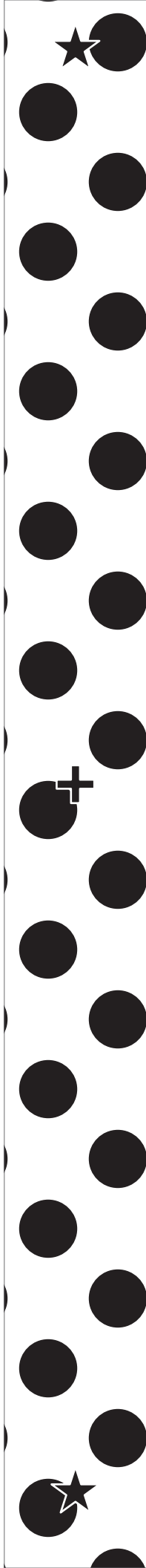
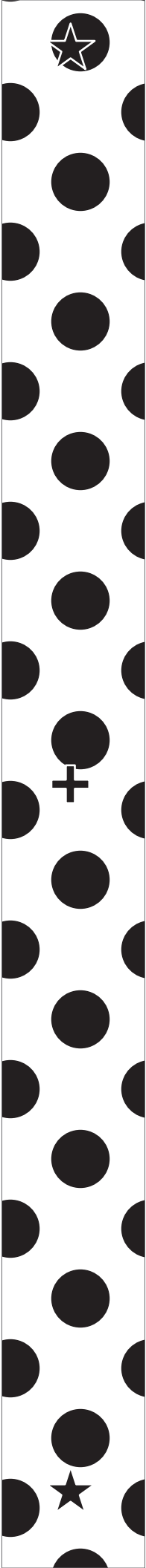
- construction paper (cut to 8.5" x 11" for printer)
- pipe cleaners
- hole punch
- glue stick
- scissors

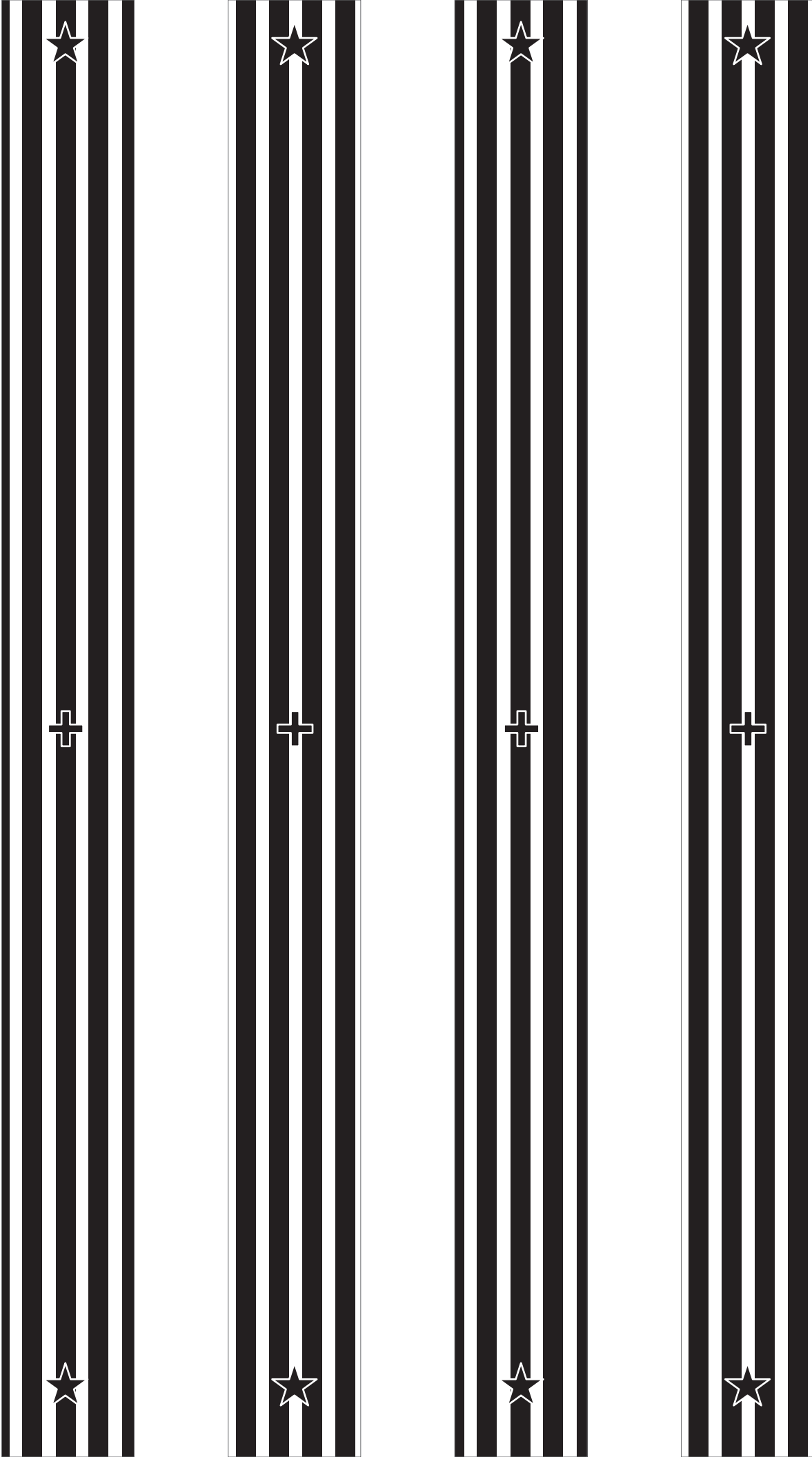
How to:

1. Print out templates on construction paper and cut them out. Construction paper is recommended instead of printer paper for these pumpkins. If you're making larger pumpkins, I'd recommend using poster board or card stock.
2. Use a hole punch to punch holes in the stars on the ends of each strip (2 holes each).
3. Line up the crosses in the middle of the strips and arrange as shown while glueing each layer down.



4. Flip over and bring the ends of each strip together forming a pumpkin-shape. Use pipe cleaners through the punch holes to secure in place. Use pipe cleaners, ribbon stickers, glitter and more to further dress up your pumpkin!
